# Internal Revenue Service – Scott Abrams www.IRS.gov (look under Charities)

The IRS has automatically revoked the tax exempt status of many Crime Stoppers
Organizations for not filing their 990N form online. These programs may not
know that their tax exempt status have been revoked and now that are not legally
eligible to except donations. Scott felt that CSUSA should alert those programs
and he will write an article about this for the newsletter.

### **Crime Stoppers International – Scott Abrams**

• After our last discussion about CSI at the June Board Meeting, he received word that there were comments made outside of the meeting expressing disagreement about where CSI is heading with their new business model.
