Hi

I have been a frequent user of my local crime alert program. When I say frequent I mean I have called in several tips with 4 of them leading to arrest. I just got my most recent capture on 2/10/09 and will receive the reward after the board meets on the first week of the march.

I also am working on tips on three other wanted felons on my local crime alert. One of those there is a good chance he may be caught by the end of the month thus meaning I will be able to collect two separate rewards the first week of March.

By now you are asking how this is possible without knowing each wanted criminal. I will start by telling you that I have always had the knack of catching criminals be they car, thief's, drug dealers and so on in my community. I have even helped two different lone police officers arrest someone from just being in the right place at the right time to be able to help them out when they needed it. In the last 16 years I have helped caught over 10 criminals be it petty thieves car thieves or now felons from the safety of my own home

I have been offered a informant basis position by two different police agencies one being federal, I did accept one agencies offer. And get paid when I setup felons for them

How I went from catching car thieves and other petty criminals to catching violent felons on crime alert is easy. One evening I was bored, So I challenged myself I wanted to put my 20 years of computer and online skills to use along with my knack for catching criminals. In a way marry the two.

So I went to my local crime alert website and simply took names of wanted felons and searched for them online. Within 20 minutes I found the first person. A wanted PAL. So being male I made a fake female yahoo profile and started chatting with him through that I got enough info on him through email to phone in a tip. I also called Local CDC office and left a message with his parole agent. Saying that I am chatting with your parolee. I called in the tip to crime alert but I have to remain anonymous.

So I told the parole agent to email me on the fake female account I am using to chat with his Parolee. So that I may remain anonymous. Two weeks into chatting with the parolee he wanted to meet. The parole agent gave me a cell number of a female officer to email to the parole. At that time the parolee called the female officer and he met for what he thought was gonna be a date.

It is to the point to where one lady that I always talk to at crime alert she knows what I do. She knows the tips I send in are good and she always sends them to the same officers that helped me catch my first PAL.

So I usually find a lot of the wanted felons on crime alert online on MySpace FaceBook yahoo and such. I chat with them using my fake female profile get what info I need and call it in. My tip goes something like this. I found so and so online I am chatting with him using the fake name of Sherri I told him I am blonde single and 27 years old and live in Sacramento. He wants me to call him and gave me his cell number.

Please note I don't call anyone wanted felons I find online I cant I am male and I leave the direct contact and arrest to the officers.

I know what the police are doing when they get the tip they are having a female officer call the felon and play the part of Sherri that I started. Sometimes though just through chatting online with them I get addresses and or residential and or cell phone numbers. It is really that simple

I am writing you because I hope that one day crime alert and or law enforcement in general will Search for criminals online before they go public and online with their wanted posters. It only takes me about 30 minutes to do a search to see if I can find a certain person active online be it on MySpace facebook twitter or many many other sites. If they are online it is easier to set them up if they aren't already on a crime stopper website

I find them using their nickname, real names or a common one is they will use their middle name as their first

name along with their legal last name.

The rate I am going I will be able to setup 10 criminals within a year time just from my own local crime alert website. Multiply that per crime alert org just in California and your talking major savings at a time when I am sure donations are down. And when you cant find the wanted felon out on the street finding him active online is the next best thing. And being online they can check and know if they are on crime alert. It then makes the setup tougher cause you have to gain the felons trust online for him to give you any contact info through simple chat by email

I have a officer from one agency that always sends me the names of fugitives he is looking for that he is unable to locate. Because they know it is almost 50/50 that I can find that wanted felon online. You yourself might be surprised how easy it is to find wanted felons online. And how easy it is to set them up specially if they aren't already posted on crime alert.

It is my hope that one day crime stopper orgs nation wide would practice this. After all with the size of the internet and the data base just on MySpace and Facebook alone it is like two worlds the real world and the cyber world.

I am hoping one day to do training for any agencies interested on the technique art of both finding and setting up wanted criminals online. I am currently working on the material and the do's and don'ts when doing online stings.

Do to my "hobby" I will end this email remaining as anonymous as possible and just use my first name an saying thank you for your time. Feel free to email me any thoughts or questions you have.
