Subject: Reward Raised in Chemical Robbery

Kansas City, MO --- On February 4th, 2007, at least two suspects made their way into the Sanofi-Aventis Pharmaceuticals complex on Marion Park Drive in south Kansas City. Once inside they handcuffed a security guard to a stairway rail and made off with a large quantity of ephedrine, a common chemical used in clandestine labs to manufacture the illegal drug, methamphetamine, or meth. Area media was given video from the scene shortly after the crime occurred.

Officials from the company's corporate headquarters in Bridgewater, New Jersey have added \$10,000 to the reward for information leading to an arrest in the case making a total possible cash reward of \$11,000. At this time there is no company spokesperson to comment on the case.

Anyone with information is asked to call Crime Stoppers at 816-474-TIPS. All calls are taken anonymously and the reward will be paid in cash to any caller whose information solves this crime.

REWARD AGREEMENT

This Agreement entered into this 20th day of April, 2007, between Sanofi-Aventis U.S. LLC, with principal offices at 55 Corporate Dr., Bridgewater, NJ 08807, phone # 816-966-5100(hereinafter, the “Contributor”), and the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission, a Missouri nonprofit corporation (hereinafter, the “Commission”).

In consideration of the following mutual covenants and agreements the parties agree:

1. The purpose of this Agreement is to offer and pay a reward up to \$10,000 for information leading to the earliest possible identification and arrest of the person(s) responsible for the robbery of Sanofi-Aventis that occurred at 10236 Marion Park Dr., Kansas City, MO on February 4, 2007.
2. Contributors have deposited, or promptly after the effective date of this Agreement, shall deposit the Reward with the Commission to be held for payment and distribution by the Commission as hereinafter provided.
3. The Commission shall administer and publicize the Reward and shall deposit the Reward in a special reward account maintained at a financial institution in the greater Kansas City, Missouri area. The Commission shall make payment or distribution of the reward, or any part thereof, only under the terms and conditions hereinafter set out:

- a. All persons who are entitled to receive awards are included in the offer of the Reward.
 - b. Payment of the Reward, or any part thereof, shall be made only to such person or persons who, in the sole and exclusive judgment of the Commission, furnishes information leading to the identification and arrest of the person or persons responsible for the crime.
 - c. Such information must be reported to the Kansas City Metropolitan Crime Commission, 3100 Main, Suite 201, Kansas City, MO 64111, telephone (816) 960-6800, or the Crime Stoppers ***TIPS HOTLINE***, telephone 816-474-8477, about the aforementioned crime prior to midnight, D.S.T., October 20, 2007, (6 months from the date of this Agreement), at which time the offer of the Reward shall automatically terminate, unless this time is extended by written agreement between the parties hereto.
 - d. Upon termination of the offer of Reward, the offer of Reward shall be null and void and of no further force and effect.
4. The Board of Directors of the Commission shall have the sole and exclusive authority to determine all matters concerning the administration, publication, payment and distribution of the Reward, including without limitation:


- a. Any dispute as to eligibility to receive the Reward, or any part thereof;
- b. Any other matter connected with the payment or distribution of the Reward or compliance with the terms and conditions of the offer of Reward, and
- c. In the event that two or more persons provide information which falls within the offer of Reward, a just and fair division of the payment of the Reward, the total of which division shall not exceed the total amount of the Reward.


The decision of the Board of Directors of the Commission in all such matters shall be binding and final on all parties interested, including all parties hereto, and all contributors, claimants, or persons furnishing such information.

- 5. The Commission shall use its best efforts to determine that leads and information received as a result of the offer of Reward are fully developed by the appropriate law enforcement agency with the purpose of arresting the person or persons responsible for the crime.
- 6. In the event the offer of Reward terminates as herein provided or for any reasons does not become due and payable, the Reward, \$10,000, will be promptly returned to the Contributor.

7. All costs of administering the Reward, including without limitation, the cost of publication, shall be borne by the Contributors up to and including \$50. The Contributors shall pay such costs promptly upon demand therefore by the Commission.
8. It is understood and agreed that the Commission may place the Reward in an interest bearing account until the Reward becomes payable or until the offer of Reward is terminated and the amount of Reward returned to the Contributors. All interest earned on the Reward shall be retained by the Commission to defray its expenses in administering the Reward.
9. The Contributors hereby release the Commission, its directors, members, employees, and any other person, firm, corporation or entity acting on its behalf, from all claims, actions, demands, liabilities or obligations of any kind, whether known or unknown, arising out of or which may hereafter arise out of, or in any manner be connected with, the administration, publication or distribution of the Reward.
10. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws in the State of Missouri.
