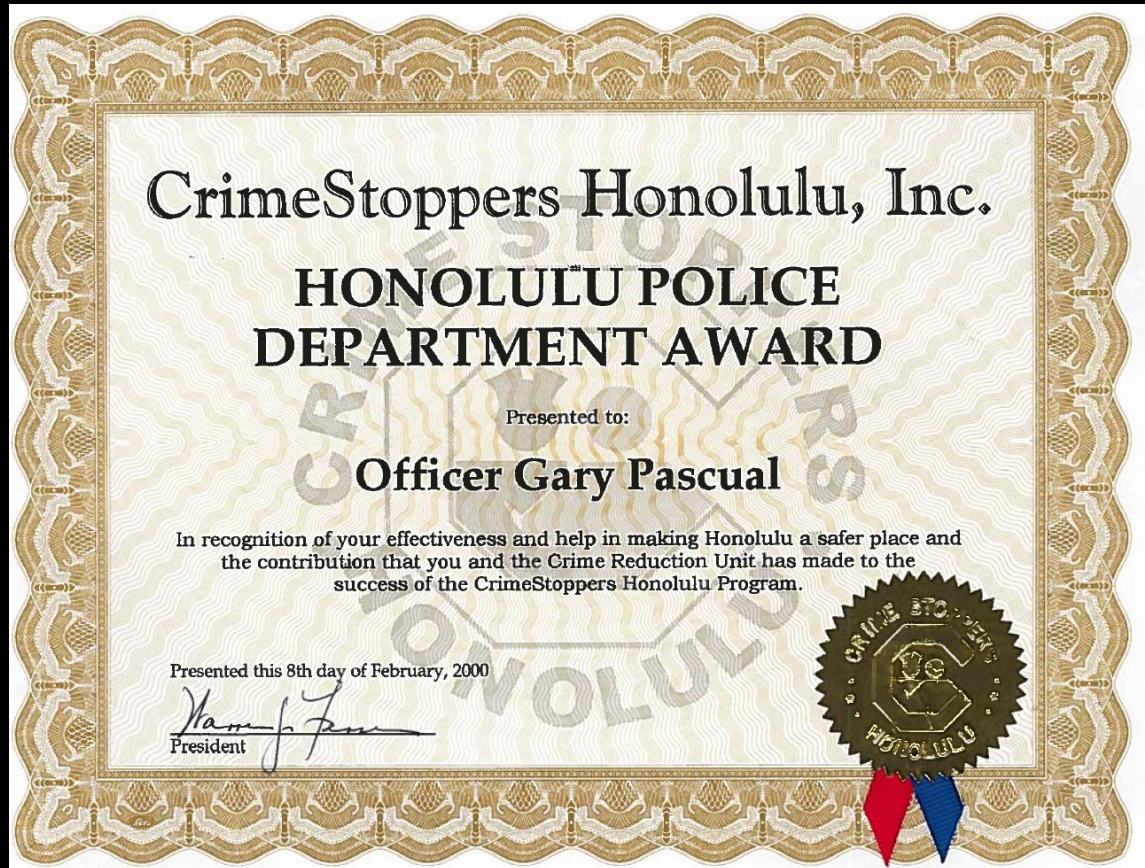

What type of questions should I ask?

These are some of the questions you may ask of the caller, but it's not an exhaustive list.

- **The address where you suspect drug activity.**
- **Where are the drugs being sold?**
- **What makes you think they are being sold there?**
- **Full names of the people you suspect and the nicknames that they use.**
- **What types of drugs are being sold?**

What type of questions should I ask?

- **Do you know how much they are being sold for?**
- **When is the location the busiest?**
- **Is there any system used by which the dealer makes it known that they are “open for business” e.g. a bedroom light on, hood of car up?**
- **Where do they keep the drugs?**
- **Does the dealer come out of the house to meet people?**
- **Do you know any of the hiding places for the drugs, in a shed / car etc?**

What type of questions should I ask?

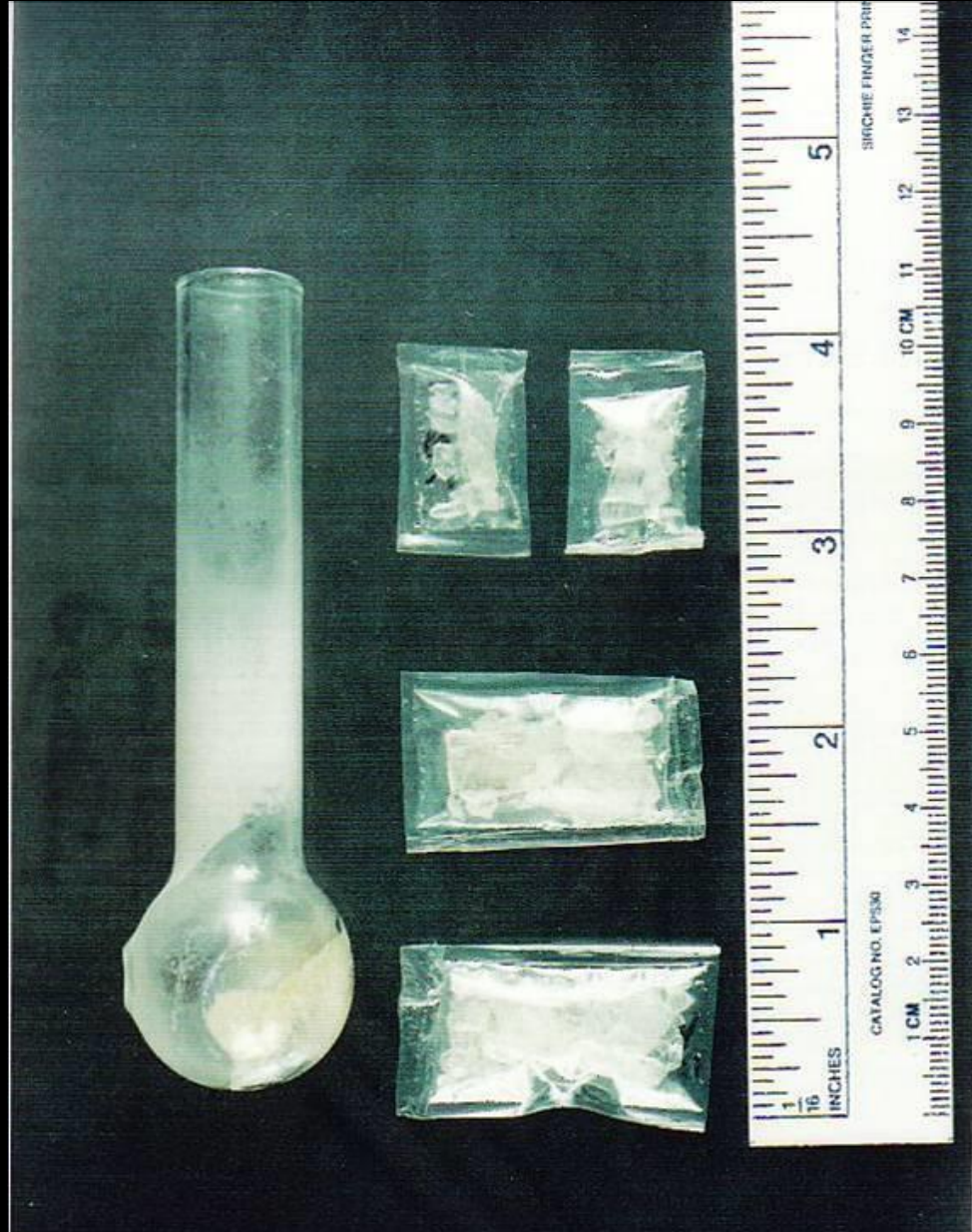
- **Are there regular cars pulling up and do you know the license plates?**
- **Do you know when supplies arrive? This may lead to a supplier further up the chain.**
- **Related vehicles – make, model, license plate**
- **When people come and go, how long do they stay, how often they come.**
- **Information about any packages being exchanged**
- **Are there children? Dogs?**
- **Is there anything else authorities should know about the location?**
