- AREA WINERIES DONATE TASTING FEES (USUALLY \$10.00-\$15 PER PERSON) & 2 BOTTLES OF WINE
 - WINE CAN BE PURCHASED AND STORED ON THE BUS & SOME OFFER DISCOUNTS
 - PARTICIPANTS CAN BRING FOOD AND SNACKS IN A SMALL COOLER IF THEY WISH
- 8-10 WINERIES PARTICIPATE WITH EACH BUS VISITING 5 WINERIES. THERE ARE TWO (2) ROUTES & EACH BUS HAS A MONITOR
- ALONG THE WAY EACH PARTICIPANT RECEIVES WRITTEN CLUES TO A UNSOLVED CRIME- NO STAGED CRIMES SCENES AND CRIMES ARE FROM SHORT STORIES AND USUALLY LIGHT HEARTED
