 - WINE CAN BE PURCHASED AND STORED ON THE BUS & SOME OFFER DISCOUNTS
 - PARTICIPANTS CAN BRING FOOD AND SNACKS IN A SMALL COOLER IF THEY WISH.
- 8-10 wineries participate with each bus visiting 5 wineries. There are two (2) routes & each bus has a monitor
- ALONG THE WAY EACH PARTICIPANT RECEIVES WRITTEN CLUES TO A UNSOLVED CRIME- NO STAGED
 CRIMES SCENES AND CRIMES ARE FROM SHORT STORIES AND USUALLY LIGHT HEARTED
- THE CRIME IS PRESENTED IN WRITING AND STORY INCLUDED IN A SMALL GIFT BAG. AT END OF EVENT
