This program aids law enforcement and school officials in reducing criminal activity and related problems in schools, on school grounds, and in the nearby communities. We have responded to situations involving the possession of illegal drugs and weapons, and destruction of property. We work to make our schools a safer place for our children.



- There are currently 59 schools on Oahu that are participating in the Student CrimeStoppers program
- Tips range from contraband items, fighting, theft, drugs, property damage, sex assaults, bullying and suicide.


What do we do?

- Schools will typically submit a request for a presentation.
- We speak to the students any where from Elementary to High School.
- We speak on topics such as Vaping, smoking, Internet Safety, Social Media Safety, Fighting, Bullying and Suicide awarness.
- All presentations are catered to the audience.










Student CrimeStoppers Posters

In 2018, the Student CrimeStoppers program received 252 tips from students.

- Led to 41 arrests and/or disciplinary action
- Recovered drugs and various contrabands and weapons.
- Led to the arrests of 3 juveniles for sex assault.
- Prevented fights and bullying
