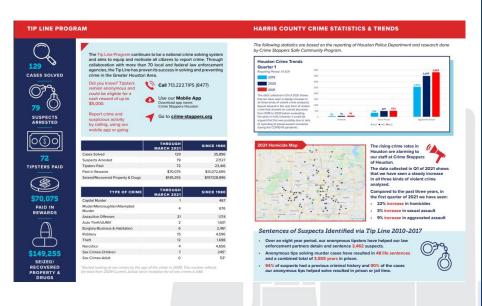

The rising crime rates in Houston are alarming to our staff at Crime Stoppers of Houston. We are dedicated to not only uncovering crippling crime trends, but also working to create positive change. Our team is working around the clock to provide innovative public safety solutions to our entire community and we hope you will join us in doing the same.

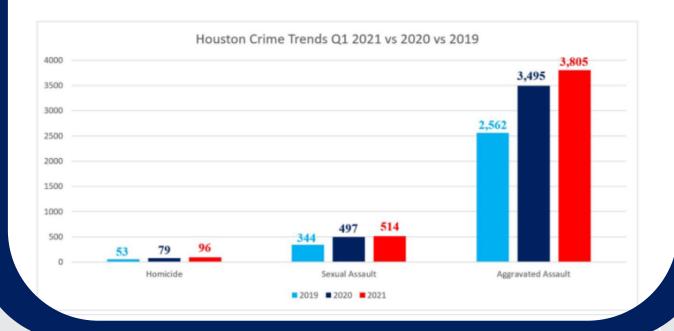
How does Houston compare to the Federal Bureau of Investigation's 2020 national crime numbers?

Violent Crimes: 183% higher than the national average

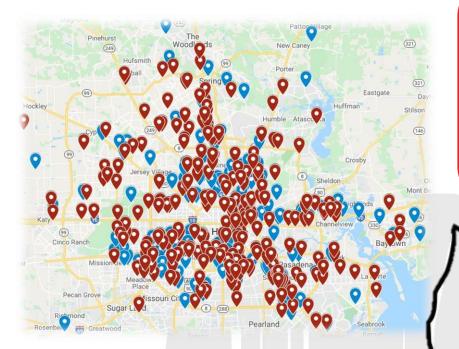
Property crimes: 105% higher than the national average

Overall: Houston crime rate is 117% higher than the national average

In 2020, Houstonians had a 1 in 991 chance of becoming a victim of violent crime and a 1 and 22 chance of becoming a victim of property crime.

COVID allowed us to reach community member across the city, state, and world in a whole new way!

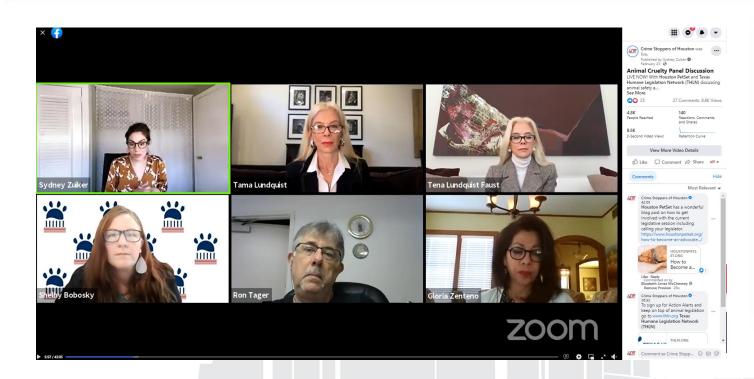

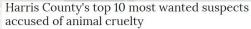
- -Utilize multimedia platforms to reach more people.

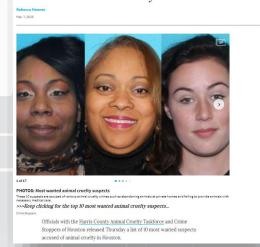

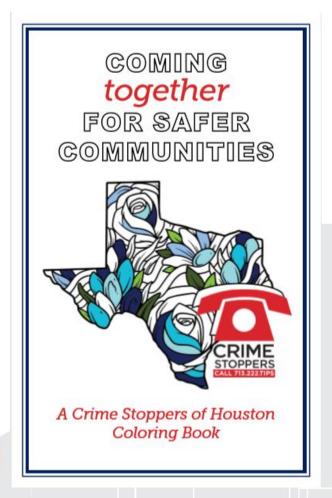
UTILIZE KEY COMMUNITY LEADERS

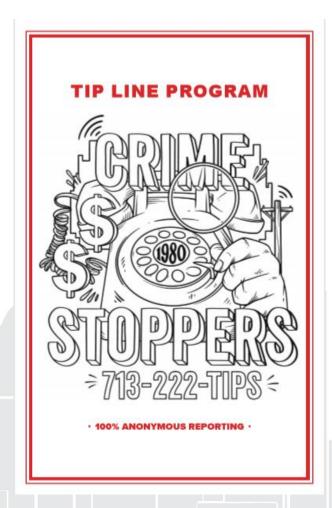
