



KYCS Locate Recovery Device

- No Monthly Fees includes 4 years of service
- Virtually undetectable by thieves/frequency scanners. KYCS Locate device shuts down and does not transmit any signals until ready to send the next update at pre-determined interval time
- Proprietary firmware and components allow for extended battery life and reduced data transmission
- Up to 5-year battery life at 1 location ping per day online battery-level monitor – replaceable battery (to customer)
- Simple installation, no wiring (self-powered), high powered magnets or 3M adhesive
- Does not affect manufacturers warranty (no OBD plugin)
- Weatherproof industrial housing
- Tamper-proof alert + removal alarm
- Coverage where cellular service is available
- Companion online portal and KYCS Locate mobile App

How Factory Installed GPS Tracking Devices Are Disabled




- All GPS Tracking systems require an antenna to send and receive data regardless of whether the GPS system is built into the firmware of the vehicle's CPU.
- Major flaw in all factory installed GPS systems: they are all installed in the same place, easily disabled
- KYCS Locate's antenna is located within the device itself, which is installed covertly

3 Simple options on how to disable your factory installed

Option 1

Simply remove the Tracking/GPS Fuse (example of OnStar)



E.g. Fuse 22 "INFO" is the GPS fuse.

Simply remove the fuse and the Manufacturer GPS system is disabled.

Option 2


Simply remove or disconnect the GPS antenna



Simply disconnect the GPS antenna

Option 3

Simply remove the serial antenna port from the CPU



Remove Antenna serial port from the CPU. Manufacturer system is disabled.

How Factory Installed GPS Tracking Devices Are Disabled





- Great solution for telematics, fleet management, data collection not designed for recovery
- OEM/GPS tracking systems repeatedly emit signals making them highly susceptible to prompt detection and removal by thieves

Used to locate tracking devices installed in vehicles


Dealerships and customers experiencing rising thefts of RVs and Trailers


- RVs and Trailers rarely recovered

Assets are equipped with KYCS Locate Devices. Locate communicates through the Locate web platform and mobile app. The KYCS Locate devices are self-powered and do not require a service tech for installation.






Key Fob Repeater Theft
